Charis is a volunteer ministry for our incarcerated brothers, and is funded by individual contributions. Men nominated for membership must be approved by the Board of Directors.

Applicants:

- a. Should complete a Cursillo, Walk to Emmaus, Tres Dias, Via de Cristo, Unidos en Cristo or similar.
- b. Must have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and recognize him as the one and only way to the father and salvation.
- c. Should attend all required team meetings and show continued support to the insiders by attending monthly reunions following the weekend.
- d. Should be actively involved in church fellowship and a prayer and share group.
- e. Shall abide by all the institution requirements and guidelines, and accept any consequences that may occur for not following them.
- f. Shall abide by all the policies and procedures of Charis.
